Skills Bootcamps are funded and flexible training courses of up to 16 weeks, which are designed in partnership with employers to provide individuals aged 19+ with sector-specific skills aligned to local employment opportunities; with guaranteed interviews or progression opportunities available upon conclusion.

Thanks to funding from the Department for Education, Skills Bootcamps are FREE for individuals registering to upskill or retrain for a new career. Employers can also use Skills Bootcamps to develop existing staff to take on additional knowledge or responsibilities; with the Department for Education covering 90% of course fees for SME businesses and 70% of fees for large employers.

MARIA'S STORY SKILLS BOOTCAMP IN PROPERTY MAINTENANCE

At 62, Maria, a self-employed careers advisor, decided it was time to gain practical skills to manage wear and tear around her home. Despite her successful career advising others, she wanted hands-on experience in property maintenance. She found the ideal opportunity through the Skills Bootcamp in Property Maintenance at Truro and Penwith College.

"For me, it wasn't just about saving money," Maria said. "I wanted to feel confident fixing things myself." While the physical side of the course surprised her at first - especially using drills and heavier tools - she quickly learned that technique mattered more than strenath.

With the guidance of her tutor, Steve, Maria steadily built her confidence. "He was so patient and made sure I understood the techniques." she said. From basic tasks like countersinking nails to more complex ones like bricklaying and plastering. Maria gained a real sense of achievement.

Now, she feels empowered to take on jobs she wouldn't have dared tackle before. She's even considering using her new skills to help others. "The course gave me more than just practical knowledge - it changed how I approach problems," she reflected.

Her message to others? "Give it a go! It's a great way to learn and could lead to more than you expect."

JUSTIN'S STORY SKILLS BOOTCAMP IN DIGITAL MARKETING

At 52, Justin from Truro decided to update his skills and explore a new direction. Through the Skills Bootcamp in Digital Marketing, he discovered a fresh passion and gained renewed confidence.

With a degree in International Business and 15 years as a Fraud Analyst in the gaming industry, Justin's background is diverse. Now an RAF reservist, he joined the Bootcamp to explore digital freelancing and stay current. "It was a low-risk way to learn how to promote business," he said.

Initially unsure about returning to education, Justin soon found the supportive environment helped ease those fears. He successfully balanced the course with work and family, enjoying the challenge of learning something new.

"The best part was getting up to date, meeting new people, and stretching my mind," he shared.

Now, he's planning to promote his own property let and pursue freelance digital marketing. His advice? "Just do it. It's free. Make the leap and go for it."

Justin's story is proof that it's never too late to embrace change and build new opportunities.

LOCAL SKILLS IMPROVEMENT PLAN - PRIORITY SECTORS FOR CORNWALL AND THE ISLES OF SCILLY

The Local Skills Improvement Plan (LSIP) for Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly was commissioned by the Department of Education and created by the Federation of Small Businesses in 2023 to identify the priorities for employer-led change in local course offerings and facilities to drive local economic development and career opportunities for individuals. The plan highlighted two priority sectors - Construction and Retrofit, and Manufacturing. Engineering and Marine - as critical areas for development.

Truro and Penwith College is proud to have secured and led a £2.5 million investment through the Local Skills Investment Fund; enhancing training infrastructure and introducing innovative programmes designed to meet both current and emerging industry needs. In addition, the 2023/2024 Apprenticeship Achievement Rate statistics published in March 2025 demonstrate that Truro and Penwith College is the best performing General FE College in the South West, within the top three in England and in the top 10% nationally for all apprenticeship providers with over 100 apprentices completing a year.

With over 30 Apprenticeship standards available for individuals aged 16 and over, the College works closely with local employers to design and deliver programmes that respond to the evolving needs of the Cornish economy. Our collaborative approach ensures that apprenticeships remain relevant, future-focused, and aligned with industry standards. In partnership with key local businesses, the College also creates bespoke Apprenticeship programmes tailored to specific workforce needs. Applicants will receive a College interview to find out more about the Apprenticeship and whether it's the right option, before being supported to apply for an Apprenticeship vacancy. For applicants who are already employed or have a suitable offer of employment, the Industry Engagement Team can facilitate the next steps for enrolment onto an apprenticeship.

HOW TO RECRUIT AN APPRENTICE

The College's Industry Engagement Team can support employers every step of the way. Whether you would like to move a current employee onto an Apprenticeship programme for professional development or recruit new members of staff for an Apprenticeship role, the team can assist at each stage of the process, from creating job descriptions, advertising vacancies, facilitating interviews and designing induction plans.

Smaller employers are eligible for government funding of between 95% and 100% of the apprenticeship costs whilst large employers can use the Apprenticeship Levy to pay for the training.

NAGINE YOUR FUTURE WITH AN ACCESS TO HE DIPLOMA: A STEPPING STONE TO UNIVERSITY AND A NEW CAREER

Truro and Penwith College offers a comprehensive Access to Higher Education programme to meet the needs of mature students. The courses are designed to give students the necessary grounding and qualifications to progress onto University courses and develop excellent skills in specific subject areas.

Funding for the Access to Higher Education Diploma is dependent on factors such as age, previous gualifications and residency status. Many of our applicants are eligible for full fee remission so the course would be fully funded. Alternatively, applicants could be eligible to apply for an advanced learner loan with Student Finance England. Under current rules, this would be written off once students have completed both the Access to HE Diploma and a higher education course.

*This does not apply to apprenticeship degrees

Funded Tuition

*The Adult Skills Fund (ASF) is a funding stream that helps adults (19+), who have lived in the UK for the last three-years and are a UK resident, to gain the skills they need in order to retrain and change careers, upskill to progress in a chosen career or to gain qualifications to access higher level learning.

- ASF funding is focused on specific provision for particular groups of learners and can be fully-funded or part-funded.
- Full-funding can be available for courses at Level 2 and Level 3 for adults who do not have a previous Level 3 gualification, other courses might be part-funded.
- All Maths and English qualifications are free (up to GCSE level) for 19+ learners who have not previously attained a GCSE at grade C, grade 4 or higher in these subjects. Learners will be required to complete a self-declaration form to confirm they do not hold the qualification.
- Free Digital Skills Qualifications (up to level 1) are available for adults who do not have the basic digital skills they need for life and work. Learners will be required to complete a self-declaration form to confirm they do not hold the qualification.
- If you are unemployed or receive benefits such as Universal Credit, Employment & Support Allowance (ESA) or Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA) some courses can be free or part-funded. Learners will be required to provide supporting evidence.
- If you are in receipt of a low-wage (up to £26,009 employed or self-employed) some courses can be free or part-funded. Learners will be required to provide supporting evidence.
- In some cases, the Government expects learners and employers to contribute to covering some of the costs of eligible courses and qualifications. In this instance the learner is 'part-funded'.

19+ Advanced Learner Loan

These are loans very much like a student loan and do not need to be paid back until you are earning over a certain wage. Advanced Learner Loans are administered by Student Finance England (SFE). Student Finance England is a Student Loans Company Service, providing financial support to students on behalf of the UK Government.

Advanced Learner Loans are available for individuals aged 19+ undertaking approved gualifications at Level 3 to 6. Advanced Learner Loans are paid directly to the College or training organisation on behalf of an individual, they are not means tested or subject to credit checks and household income is not considered. Any individual who meets the criteria will be able to apply for a loan regardless of their current employment status.

Support for employers

Through a range of UK Shared Prosperity Fund projects, the College is able to offer employers financial support with part-funding for a number of courses detailed in the CPD Course Guide, including programmes linked to Green Skills, Digital Skills and the Local Skills Improvement Plan priority sectors of Construction and Engineering. Fully-funded pilot training to hone the content of new courses developed to meet current and emerging industry needs is also available. Employing Apprentices

Government funding covers a minimum of 95% of the training costs for SMEs, with full funding now available for businesses employing an apprentice aged under 22 or between 22 and 24 with an Education, Health and Care Plan. Large employers can utilise their Apprenticeship levy funds to make Apprenticeships one of the most cost-effective training options.
